TASK DESCRIPTION

Historical Analysis: National Study – Japan 1904-1937

• Students choose one syllabus dot point under the Focus of Study – Rise of militarism in the 1930s, including:

- Political and economic impact of the Great Depression
- o Development and impact of modernisation and urbanisation and rising social tensions
- Role and significance of the army and political divisions within it
- Hostility toward the zaibatsu and the collapse of party politics

Students conduct research to find Three Primary Sources and Three Secondary Sources relevant to their chosen dot point.

Students then answer the following research questions:

- 1. Describe the historical context of your chosen syllabus dot point
- 2. Account for the perspective of each source.
- 3. Explain how each source can be used as evidence to address the syllabus point
- 4. Discuss the limitations of the source as a representation of the past

Students will structure their response as a report with headings, addressing each of the research questions.
