### TASK INSTRUCTIONS

#### **Part 1:**

1. Select a scientific or environmental issue. You may focus on your issue from a local, national and/or international perspective.
2. Research the topic with the aim of developing an individual perspective on its potential impact on the world.
3. Present your findings in the form of a PowerPoint. You should include:
  - A clear explanation of your chosen issue
  - Discuss your own informed opinion about the possible benefits and negatives your chosen issue may have on our world
  - Relevant visuals, audio, and written information

#### **Part B:**

1. You are to create a Poster Comparing and Contrasting the Themes represented in 'The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-time by Mark Haddon and 'Series 01: Episode 07 – The Dumpling Paradox' of the Big Bang Theory. Your poster should:
  - Identify the themes in both texts
  - Explain similarities and differences in themes between both texts
  - Use both written and Visual modes
