Your child has expressed interest in participating in the Semester 2 **Tamworth Basketball Competition** at **Sports Dome, Jack Smyth Drive, Tamworth** starting on **Wednesday 6th August 2025 (Term 3, week 3)**.

Competition will be every **Wednesday afternoon** as per the draw.

Parents/Carers will be responsible to transport students to and from basketball. There is no option for bus transport this Semester.

The students will depart from MCS **at the end of the school day**.

The students will return to **home**.

The students will be supervised by event staff members & parents/carers.

Students will need the following items:

- MCS basketball uniform and shoes
- Water bottle

Sporting Activity

Representing Manilla Central School is an important responsibility and a privilege. The "Sporting Code of Conduct" is designed to provide guidance relating to the behaviours expected of a representative of our school. Please read and sign the attached Code of Conduct. Please ensure your child also reads and signs the Code of Conduct.

Accident insurance information

In the event of injury, no accident or medical insurance cover is provided by the NSW Government Treasury Managed Fund for students participating in school sporting activities, physical education lessons or any other school endorsed activity, unless there is a breach of duty of care by department or school staff. The NSW Department of Education is insured to meet the financial impact of any legal liabilities arising from its activities. It does not provide, nor has it ever provided, accident or medical insurance for students enrolled in government schools.

Concussion management

When a student enrolled in a government school is diagnosed with concussion, the principal must be advised in writing as soon as the diagnosis is confirmed. Students may only return to sport and physical activity once a medical clearance has been provided to the school and, if at a school sport event, to the supervising teacher.

Any student that experiences a suspected concussion during a school endorsed activity, will be removed from the activity and parents/carers will be advised that a medical follow-up is required. If medical clearance is not provided, the student cannot participate in vigorous or competitive school sport or physical activities for 21 days from the concussion date.

Privacy advice

The NSW Department of Education is collecting the information requested on this form. The information is being obtained for the purpose of ascertaining relevant medical information, requirements and other health care related needs about your child who is currently enrolled at the school and who may participate in school excursions, sporting activities or other educational or school activities conducted by or in conjunction with Manilla Central School.

The school will use this information to plan, support students, and minimise risks when conducting the school excursions or other related school activities.

Other persons or agencies that may be provided with this information include, but are not limited to, volunteers and members of external organisations who join with the school or are otherwise involved in planning or delivering the excursion, sporting or other school activity; and persons that may be called on to provide health care treatment or other assistance during or as a consequence of such excursions or activities.

Provision of this information is voluntary, however, if you do not provide all or any of the information requested, your child cannot participate in the excursion. In such circumstances, the school will make available a sound alternative educational experience.

Provision of this information will significantly assist the school in planning a safer educational activity. It will be stored securely. If you have any concerns about provision of this information, please contact the school principal to discuss further.

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Semester 2 Basketball 2025

If you would like your child to continue to play basketball in Semester 2 or would like them to start to play in Semester 2, below are the details that you will need to know –

Fees for Semester 2

***There are no donations to offset playing fees this semester.**

Continuing Players - \$170 (only if your personal registration fee was paid this year).

***If your Personal Registration fee finished at the end of Semester 1, you will also need to pay the \$110.50 registration fee to be able to play.*

New Players = \$280.50

\$170 – Competition Fee

\$110.50 – 12mth Personal Registration Fee (includes Semester 1 2026).

Active Kids vouchers are accepted by Tamworth Basketball.

Competition

Starts Wednesday 6th August (Week 3, Term 3) and finishes on Wednesday 12th November 2025 (Week 5, Term 4).

Semis, Prelims, finals and grand finals: Wednesday 19th, 26th & 3rd December 2025.

Team Numbers

We **MUST have 8 players to be able to register and play**. If we do not have enough players, we can approach Tamworth Basketball to see if they can find teams for our players to join. We can still support with transport if this happens.

Transport

Parents/carers are required to transport players into Tamworth each week. A roster will be organised for this; if there are any preferences within the above dates, please let Mrs Ormiston know ASAP.

Please note the MCS bus is no longer a transport option.

Behaviour Expectations

As basketball is an incentives-based program and in line with our excursion policy, any student on a level **will not be eligible to play whilst on the level**. Additionally, as students are wearing the MCS basketball uniforms while at the Tamworth Sports Dome, the behavioural expectations are that our students will conduct themselves appropriately.

The nominations need to be in before the end of Term 2 to Mrs. Ormiston.

Once we have confirmation of numbers and teams, we will provide information for online registrations. Individual registrations and payments **will need to be made by the end of Week 1, Term 3**, in time for players to take the court in Week 3.
