2022 Term 4 Stage 2 Excursion – Dubbo List of items required

- 2 sets of casual/neat clothing appropriate for travel and Day 1 activities and Day 1 evening activities (no singlets or short shorts).
- Undies and socks enough for two full days of activities.
- Some warm clothing depending on the weather.
- FULL <u>Sport</u> Uniform for <u>Tuesday</u> MCS sports shirt, MCS sports shorts, MCS school hat MCS jumper, appropriate sporting footwear.
- Medication all medication in original packaging or blister pack with clear written instructions
 is to be given to Mr Scott on Monday morning. If your child suffers from travel sickness
 please ensure they take medicine before leaving on Monday and have sufficient medication
 for the return journey.
- Toiletries including deodorant, shampoo, conditioner, soap, toothbrush, tooth paste, hair brush.
- 1 set of PJ's.
- Shoes appropriate for Day 1 travel and sports shoes for Tuesday (NO THONGS).
- Plastic bags for dirty clothes.
- A backpack (to carry each day) to contain morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea for Day 1 travel. Please ensure it can be carried on back and be able to zip up to ensure the contents are safe.
- One water bottle clearly labelled. This is an essential item
- School Hat, sunscreen.
- Pillow and small blanket for bus travel.
- Mobile phones are NOT permitted unless they have a Sim card removed.
- Electronic devices/headphones/cameras are permitted but the school will not take any responsibility if they are lost or broken. <u>Sim Cards</u> are not permitted (please remove). These may be taken from students at night time and stored in a secure area.
- Spending money \$20-30. Students *may* get an opportunity to visit the gift store at the Zoo however this will be dependent on time. This needs to be kept in a wallet in the students backpack at all times.
- Monday's morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea packed in backpack for Monday
- Items for bus trip books, cards, colouring ins etc
- All items need to be clearly labelled with student's name.

Items provided

- All bedding including linen and blankets will be provided at the accommodation venues
- All meals expect for Monday morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea which students need to bring themselves.
