How many push ups can you do in 1 minute? Repeat for other physical activities.	Using a packet of <b>Smarties</b> make a graph of the different colours and how many there are of each colour.	Use magazines, catalogues or newspapers to make a shopping list. How much will your shopping cost? Will you have change from \$150?	How many times can you skip/jump/hop/catch a ball in one minute? 5 minutes?	Draw a picture using only 2D Shapes. Graph how many shapes you used.
Sort your toy box by type. Sort the dirty washing into colours, lights and darks. Sort clean washing by who it belongs to.	Create a treasure hunt. Draw a map of your house and where the treasure is located. Write a list of positional clues for a family member to follow to find your treasure.	Play a game of bust. (adding to 20), make it more difficult by adding to higher numbers. (roll 2 dice, add them, take it in turns, winner is the closest without going over)	Make a list of angles you can see in your house. Record how many are acute, obtuse, reflex or straight.
