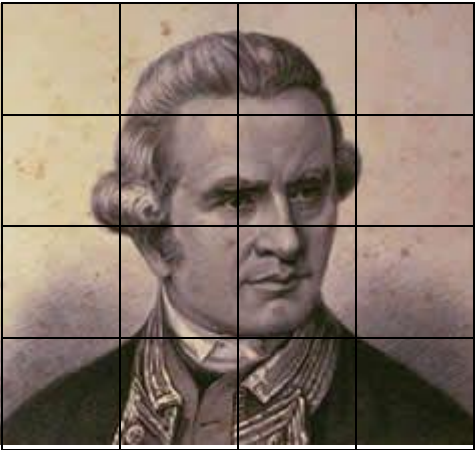

Captain Cook Portrait Challenge



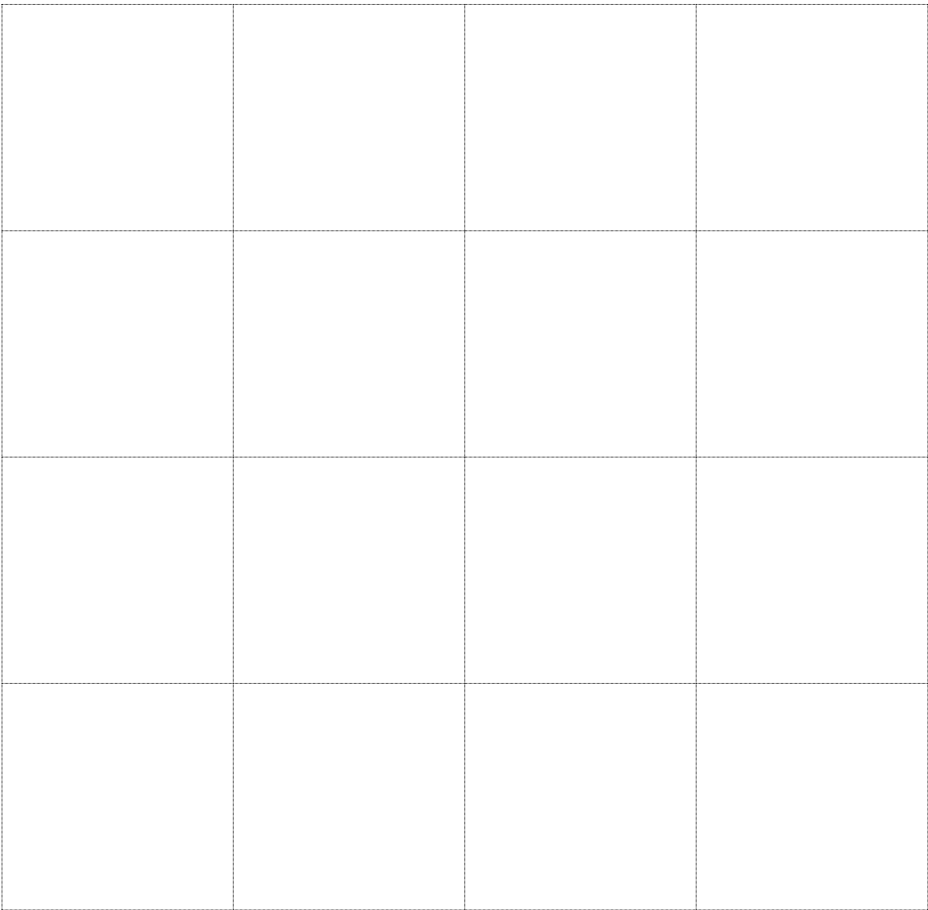
Recreate this portrait of Captain James Cook in the grid to the right. You will have noticed that your portrait will be bigger than the original.

Helpful Hints:

Look at a box on your reference picture and re-create what's inside of it in the corresponding box on your drawing paper. It's helpful to start with the boxes that include the general outline of your image in order to make sure that it will all connect properly.

Once you have the outline complete, you can begin to add in smaller details such as eyes, noses, mouths, etc. It's up to you to decide how detail you'd like your picture to be.

Make sure to use a sharpened HB pencil so that you can easily make adjustments to your drawing.

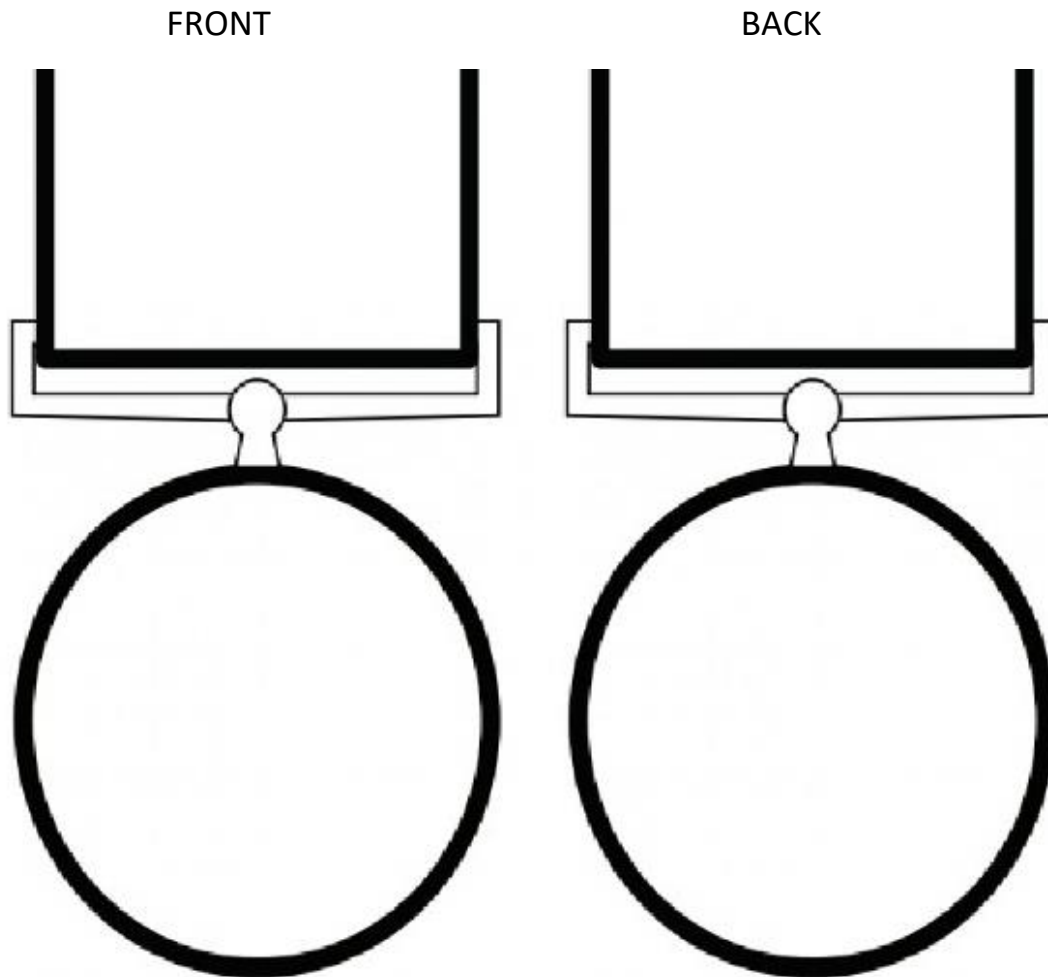
You have decided to claim this island for yourself. Create your own flag in the space below.
