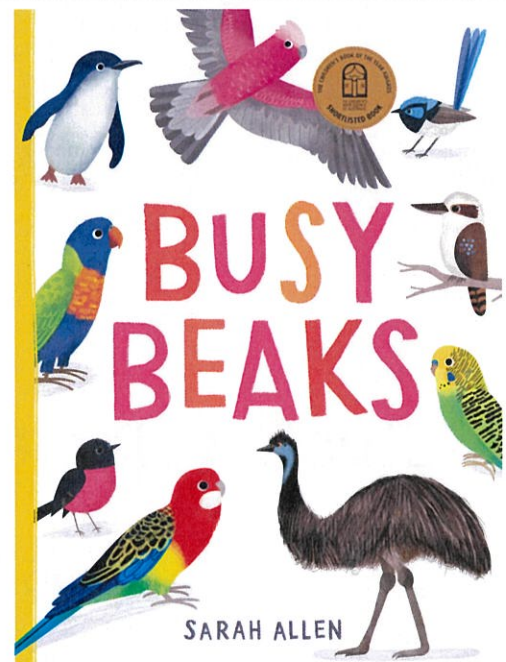

2. Glue the wings on top of the tabs.

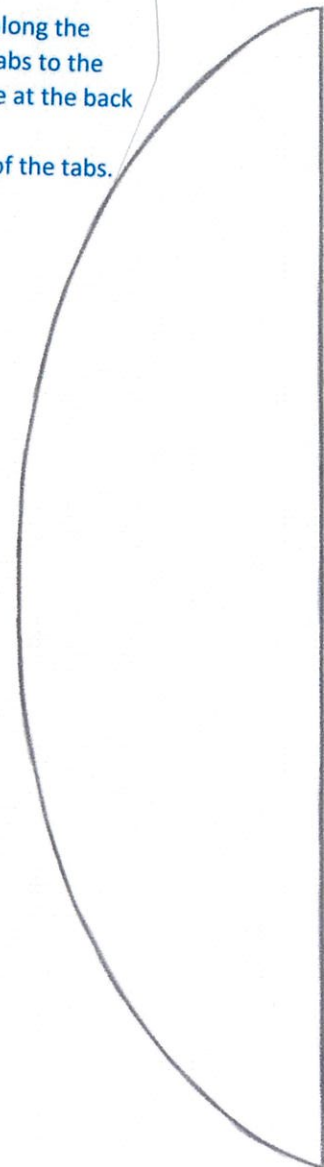


Decorate your bird with feathers on the wings and tail or anything or decorations you can find!

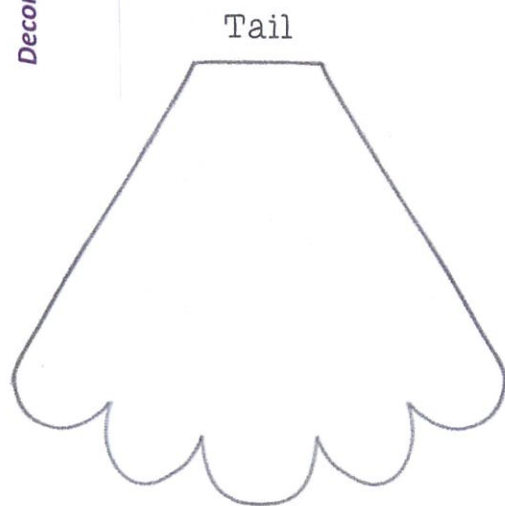

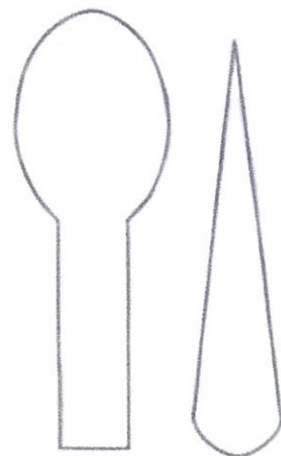
